- ✓ A reminder to all Auxiliaries and Districts.... All expenses <u>must be approved by the</u> members at a meeting prior to the event/expenditure unless allowed for in your approved standing motions. When a motion is made for an expense a dollar amount must be stated in the motion. Sometimes you may not always know the amount needed. In that case the motion should state a "not to exceed amount of." Example: Your secretary needs a new briefcase, but not sure how much it will be. The motion can be made stating amount spent not to exceed \$100.00. Please refer to page 7 in the ritual section of the 2024 Podium Book for managing a simple motion.
- ✓ If the President, Treasurer or Secretary are an annual member, their annual dues must be paid no later than December 31, 2024. As per National If dues are not paid by the President, Treasurer or Secretary by January 4, 2025, the Department must submit an e-mail or letter on January 5, 2025, requesting the non-paid Officer be relieved of their position. FYI.... Any annual member who does not pay their dues by December 31, 2024, is **no longer a member in good standing**. Be sure to check those membership cards at your January meeting.

Sec. 104—Members in Good Standing \checkmark

A. The membership year of the Auxiliary is from January 1 to December 31.

1. A member who has paid their dues to December 31 is in good standing.

2. A member ceases to be in good standing on January 1 immediately following the year for which dues have been paid.

- 3. A member shall not be in good standing again until their dues have been paid for the current year.
- 4. Continuous membership begins again upon payment of dues.
- 5. Dues must be paid by June 30 to remain a continuous member.
- 6. Prior year's dues may not be paid after July 1.

7. Any member who has not maintained continuous membership shall submit an application and be accepted in the same manner as a new member.

- 8 No admission fee shall be required.
- 9. Date of rejoin starts new continuous membership.



- ✓ SECTION 810A ATTENDANCE: Assure that the President or their Representative attend all properly called District Convention or Meetings. The District Secretary to report to OA Chairman immediately after SOI's and District with a list of names, title, and Auxiliary number of those who attended. Trustees are encouraged to attend the Department and District School. If meetings are available in a virtual setting, an Auxiliary Member Representative must call in or join virtually staying for the entire meeting to count towards attendance
- ✓ **Centennial Book:** Just a reminder to past department presidents, take the time to look through your historian books. I am sure you all have some wonderful photos. To clear up any misunderstandings. The photo release form is also a way to obtain information about the photo to enable us to know who, what, where and why of the photo. I have had several members reach out about if the member in the photo is deceased what to do. You do not need their consent. We just want to be sure that any photos that are published in the book, the individual in the photo who is living agrees with it. The last thing we want is to publish the book and a member's photo be in the book and they are not happy about it. We need to remember this book is a collection of 100 years of our organization, it will be a book you want to keep.

March 31, 2025, Deadline

Young American Creative Patriotic Art & 3-Dimensional Patriotic Art Contests

There are two categories for this contest which is open to students in **grades 9-12** by March 31, 2025, deadline. **Both categories have the same rules:**

- ✓ If the American Flag is used, it must conform to the Federal Flag Code in relation to colors, number of stars and stripes and other pertinent rules of the code.
- ✓ Complete typed explanation of the entry (250 words or less) along with application with parent or guardian signature and include it with the entry.
- \checkmark Entry must be completed during the current school year.
- A. Two Dimensional: National Scholarships First place \$15,000
 - Entry must be on canvas or paper, watercolor, pencil, pastel, charcoal, tempera, crayon, acrylic, pen, ink, oil, marker, or other media may be used.
 - Entries may not be smaller than 8" x 10" and not larger than 18" x 24", INCLUDING mat.
 - * Digital art and photography are not accepted.
- **B. Three Dimensional:** National Scholarships First place \$2,500
 - * Entry may be paper, papier mâché, pottery, sculpture, fabric, wood, metalwork, etc.
 - \clubsuit Entry may not be larger than 18" in any direction and may not weigh more than 5 pounds.
 - * Digital art, photography, weapons, art generated by a 3-D printer and jewelry are NOT accepted.

Article VII OFFICERS:

Sec. 801 – Eligibility: Any member in good standing shall be eligible to any office in the Auxiliary, County Council, District, Department, or the National Organization in which they are a member.

• No member shall hold two (2) elective offices on the same level at the same time.

• The member may hold one (1) elective and one (1) or more appointive offices on that level.

• The exception to this rule being that a Trustee may hold another elective or appointive office other than President, Secretary, or Treasurer.

• Officers, elective or appointive, may hold office in a higher or lower body and such offices may be held concurrently, (i.e., a District President could be elected as a Department Officer. This is not holding two (2) elective offices on the same level.)

• Any member who has been removed from office in accordance with Section 809B shall not be eligible for election to that office during the current Auxiliary year.

SEC. 802 – ELECTIVE OFFICERS.

Department elective officers shall include the District Presidents as elected by the districts.

Sec. 303—Department Meetings and Convention

A. Delegates and Alternates to the Department Convention shall be elected at a regular meeting of the Auxiliary held not less than thirty (30) calendar days prior to the Department Convention:

1. One (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate for each thirty (30) members or fraction thereof in good

standing in the Auxiliary at the time of the election of Delegates.

a. Or as the Department Bylaws provide.

2. The Auxiliary Secretary shall send the names of the Delegates and Alternates to the Department Secretary prior to the close of the credentials of the Department Convention.
