Remember I need your reports by the 14<sup>th</sup> of each month. Include the number of members involved and the number of hours spent on the event, please.

For those that have not reported: Perhaps you do not realize that our reporting year begins May 1<sup>st</sup>. I am sure most of you took part in a Memorial Day event. Report it.

When we educate our youth about patriotism, we help them develop good citizenship. 

# Treasurer's Page

Changes are coming to MALTA in January 2026 that will affect Treasurers. There will be a new shortcut button added that will enable treasurers to track new credit card applications. The Department treasurer will be uploading a PDF of the membership application into MALTA so that the application will follow the member, and the Department will not have to keep paper copies, nor make electronic copies. Any transfer will be handled in the same way, the auxiliary votes on accepting the transfer, the Department Treasurer will transfer within the state, National will handle between states. The new application will then be uploaded to MALTA once completed.

New redesigned APPLICATION coming that should be available online in November 2025 and available for ordering new brochures shortly thereafter. This new redesign should make it easier to fill out for the applicant and the auxiliary. There is no space for a credit card, but it allows a credit card to be used for both life and annual memberships and as gifts. Once the member is processed in MALTA, they will be sent a link that will allow them to input their credit card information. This link can be by email or SMS and will work for 30 days. If the membership is not paid for within the 30 days, the membership is voided and will have to be resubmitted. The auxiliary will have to get any admission fee separately from the membership fee as the link will only charge the membership fee.

When can you use old applications?

Old application forms can be used to process all memberships until December 31, 2025, but because of the change in handling credit cards, no old application forms will be accepted beginning January 2026. Any application that does not have Revised January 2026 will be returned to the submitting auxiliary for correction to the new form.

The Change/Update Form is being redesigned also. It will enable a member to convert to life via credit card by using MALTA or calling a phone number listed on the form.
