New Charter Feature in MALTA

1-5-2024 Memo Form VFW Auxiliary National:

A new feature of being able to order a replacement charter has been added in MALTA for Treasurers. A Treasurer from an Auxiliary or District may order a replacement charter for their organization under their Duties tab in MALTA in the Manage Auxiliary or District section. Department Treasurers may order a replacement charter for a subordinate entity of the Department (this is similar when a Department pays a bond or makes a gift on behalf of one their subordinates). The Department may choose whether to have the replacement charter mailed to the Department Treasurer or the subordinate entity's Treasurer. Please note that a Department may not order a replacement charter for the Department itself.

There are two options when ordering a replacement charter. The options are as follows:

- 1.A full size (11 x 17) color replacement charter for \$25. These are printed by the VFW and the VFW Auxiliary does not control the timeline in which these will be printed and sent.
- 2.A smaller (8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11) black and white replacement charter for \$15. These will be printed by the VFW Auxiliary and should be received within one month of ordering.

Serve food at soup kitchens or distribute food at food banks/cupboards.

Drive for Meals on Wheels or help prepare food for delivery.

Help your local library by working at book fairs.

Assist local youth groups and senior centers.

Help your town or city during elections but remain non-partisan.

Partnerships can be a single-day event or ongoing events throughout the year

Auxiliary Outreach is donating your blood sweat and tears to an organization outside of vour own.

Auxiliary Outreach is not writing checks, collecting items or money for another organization, baking, food preparation, participating in events... Whatever you do in community service, turn this into your Post. They can add this to their **Community Activities reports.**

Buddy" [®] Poppy/National Home Program-November 2023 Department of Virginia National Ambassador, Lisa Jackson Department Chair, Kathy Voss



It is time to finalize plans for your submission to the Department "Buddy"[®] Poppy Display Contest. Please take time to review the rules and judging criteria below so you are familiar with the rules and regulations. Also, please note... the the new poppies are available for purchase through your Post! Either type of poppy maybe be used in the competition.

Displays will be presented and judged in three categories:

Category 1.

Public Promotion of Poppy Campaign (Window, booth, parade, poster displays, campaign promotions, etc.) Displays must be designed for public exposure and must bear a message soliciting a donation for and wearing of the VFW Buddy Poppy. At least one Poppy used in the display must be in its original form and color, with label attached.

Category 2.

Memorial or Inspirational Displays (Wreaths, memorial tablets or plaques, patriotic or devotional themes) Displays must be designed to honor the dead, to inspire devotion to God and Country, or to dramatize the activities supported by the Buddy Poppy. At least one Poppy used in the display must be in its original form and color, with label attached.

Category 3.

Artistic or Decorative Use of Poppies (Post Home displays, table centerpieces, corsages, pictures, plaques, models, scenes, hats, novelty pieces, etc.) Any display not meeting the qualifications for Categories 1 or 2 shall automatically be entered in Category 3.

At least one Poppy used in the display must be in original form and color, with label attached.

At the time the display is set up, the responsible person must complete an entry form which will show the category of competition, the number of Poppies used, the purpose of the display, the Post and/or Auxiliary number and location, and the name of the person who will dismantle and remove the display at the close of the Convention. Displays may be accompanied by a white card, not to exceed 4 X 6 inches in size, on which is lettered in black ink an explanation of the theme for the display or other information of interest to the viewer or the judges. *Post name, Post number, city or state (including the shape of your state) may NOT be visible on display entries; failure to comply will result in disqualification.* Any use of non-VFW trademarks or copyrighted material on your display must have prior approval from the trademark or copyright holder. These include but are not limited to names, logos, audio/visual graphics, images and/or props. The VFW and Buddy Poppy logo and name is authorized but use of any outside organization trademark or copyrighted material and/or logos must have prior approval through their respective organization.

Displays will be judged on effectiveness, purpose, clarity of theme, suitability, originality, beauty and number of Poppies used. Where a sample of many identical items (such as corsages or wreaths) is entered, full credit shall be given for the total number of Poppies used.

Prizes will be awarded to the first, second, and third place winners in each of the three categories where qualifying entries were submitted.

Are the Auxiliaries doing projects, promotions, and donations for our National and Department Programs?

As Chief of Staff, I should be advised by the <u>DISTRICT PRESIDENTS</u> if the Auxiliaries are not getting these "to-dos" completed by the deadline requested. **DISTRICT PRESIDENTS AND DISTRICT MENTORS** keep eyes and ears for any <u>*RED FLAGS*</u> in your District.

Remember, Auxiliaries may not be perfect, but some of them are close. Give Auxiliaries a pat on the back or a Good Job Award Citation. (You can find the citation on MALTA Member Resources under Extension & Revitalization.) This Auxiliary may even help mentor another Auxiliary by sharing ideas on how they do things.

Remember, **<u>DISTRICT PRESIDENTS</u>**, you know your Auxiliaries. So please keep in contact with them. Have that communication and your ears open. Listen before you speak and be kind to everyone. Together we can get our Auxiliaries to *Band Together for Our Veterans*.

LEGISLATIVE February

I want to wish all of you and your families a

Our National President Carla Martinez's theme for 2023-2024 is: **BANDING TOGETHER FOR OUR VETERANS** The best way to band together is to support legislation in support of our VETERANS!

Take this time to think about our veterans, service men & women and their families. It is our duty to educate our communities and young civic organization members the importance of standing up to protect their rights and benefits. A simple way to help them be informed is having them sign up for VFW Action Corps weekly. **You can use the following to sign up:** QR Code (reach out to me for this information), Text "VFW" to 50457, Visit vfw.org/Join Action Corps weekly.

"All Legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives." (Article I, Section 1, of the United States Constitution)

To help us understand the process of a bill becoming a law information can be found at www.house.gov

House Floor Consideration

- Consideration of a measure by the full House can be a simple or very complex operation. In general, a measure is ready for consideration by the full House after it has been reported by a committee. Under certain circumstances, it may be brought to the Floor directly.
- The consideration of a measure may be governed by a "rule". A rule is itself a simple resolution, which must be passed by the House, that sets out the particulars of debate for a specific bill—how much time will be allowed for debate, whether amendments can be offered, and other matters.
- Debate time for a measure is normally divided between proponents and opponents. Each side yields time to those members who wish to speak on the bill. When amendments are offered, these are also debated and voted upon. If the House is in session today, you can see a summary of Current House Floor Proceedings.
- After all debate is concluded and amendments decided upon, the House is ready to vote on final passage. In some cases, a vote to "recommit" the bill to committee is requested. This is usually an effort by opponents to change some portion or table the measure. If the attempt to recommit fails, a vote on final passage is ordered.
- Votes on final passage, as well as all other votes in the House, may be taken by the electronic voting system which registers each individual member's response. These votes are referred to as Yea/Nay votes or recorded votes, and are available in House Votes by bill number, roll call vote number or words describing the reason for the vote.
- Votes in the House may also be by voice vote, and no record of individual responses is available.

Remember if you are submitting an entry for a National Legislative award for Auxiliaries No. 1, please be sure to have the entry to me before March 31, 2023. If you need this form, please contact me. Remember to report to me. *Are you working with Young Civic groups?* Please keep in mind I have awards to be given away at convention in June.

SECTION 810A ATTENDANCE: Assure that the President or their Representative attend all properly called District Convention and Meetings. The <u>District Secretary</u> to report to OA Chairman immediately after SOI's and District with a list of names, title, and Auxiliary number of those who attended. District Presidents please keep the Auxiliaries in your District informed of the date and location of your District Meeting and District Conventions.



ATTENTION ANNUAL MEMBER. If you have not paid your 2024 Membership Dues you need to do as soon as possible. Reminder if you do not renew by June 30th you will need to rejoin.



AUXILIARY TREASURERS. Please take a moment to review the monetary requirements for Outstanding Auxiliary to be sure your Auxiliary has met the requirements. Ways to pay the monetary donations are available on the Outstanding Auxiliary guide.

SEC. 806—INSTALLATION:

<u>Sec. 806A—Auxiliary Installation:</u> Auxiliary Officers shall be installed in their respective offices not more than <u>sixty (60) calendar days prior to the convening of</u> <u>the Department Convention on June 13, 2024</u>.

Sec. 806C—District Installation: The District Officers shall be installed before adjournment of the meeting at which elected.

- Installation form must be entered into Malta by District/Auxiliary Secretary or sent to the Department Secretary to enter into Malta by the Auxiliary/District Secretary within 7 days after the election or installation of Officers.
- <u>All Auxiliary and District installation reports MUST be received at National Headquarters</u> and the Department Secretary by June 30, 2024.
- If you cannot elect officers, contact President Butler immediately after your meeting.

ARTICLE III AUXILIARY DELEGATES:

<u>Sec. 303—District Meetings and Convention</u>: Delegates and Alternates to Districts shall be elected at a regular meeting of the Auxiliary held not less than thirty (30) calendar days **prior** to the District Convention at which District Officers are to be elected. • One (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate for each fifteen (15) members or fraction thereof in good standing in the Auxiliary at the time of the election of Delegates. <u>Delegates form must be to District Secretary before start of District Convention</u>.

<u>Sec. 304—Department Meetings and Convention</u>: Delegates and Alternates to the Departments shall be elected at a regular meeting of the Auxiliary held **not less than** thirty (30) calendar days prior to the Department Convention on <u>June 13, 2024</u>: • One (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate for each thirty (30) members or fraction thereof in good standing in the Auxiliary at the time of the election of Delegates. <u>Delegates form must be to Department Secretary by 5-26-2024</u>.

<u>Sec 305 National Delegates:</u> "Delegates and Alternates to the National Convention shall be elected at the last regular meeting in April; one for each fifty (50) members or fraction thereof in good standing on **March 31.** The VFW Auxiliary Secretary shall provide the names of the Delegates and Alternates to the National Secretary, along with their membership ID number, within thirty (30) calendar days of the day of election" and <u>no later than 5-31-2024</u>. Fillable applications are available on our website: https://vfwauxva.org then under News, them Events or by emailing ellenstogsdill@cox.net 757-777-7194. There is also a form in this communication.

<u>Sec. 810—President, Duties of (All Levels): (Paragraph D)</u>: The President of the Auxiliary to a Department, District or Post shall, within thirty (30) days after installation into office, submit to the Commander of the respective Department, District or Post the last quarterly audit, membership status report, and such additional reports as may be required by the liaison committee. (National President see Section 810E). 1. Such reports will be acknowledged by each respective Commander during the next regular meeting of the Post over which they preside and may be read to the members assembled.

<u>Sec 814 Duties of Trustees:</u> All Auxiliaries and Districts MUST be bonded by <u>August 31, 2024</u>, by the Auxiliary and District Treasurer.

Sec. 506 District Dues: District dues must be paid to the District Treasurers by September 30, 2024.

Department, District and Auxiliary Officers (Presidents, Secretaries and Treasurers) dues MUST be paid by **December 31, 2024,** or submit an email or letter to relieve any non-paid Officers to National Headquarters by January 5, 2025.

<u>All Members</u>, please take time today to sign into MALTA and confirm that your information is correct in MALTA. National and Department uses your profile information in Malta to send you information.

- Auxiliary installation report must be received by National Headquarters by June 30, 2024. This can be entered through MALTA. If you enter through MALTA, please provide the information to the Department Secretary. If unable to access MALTA, please send to the Department Secretary by June15, 2024 for submission. If the installation report is not received by National Headquarters by June 30, 2024, the report must be mailed to the National Headquarters for input. If not received by July 31, 2024, at National Headquarters, the Department MUST submit a request for suspension to allow time to mentor and rejuvenate. Sec 806A Auxiliary. TIP: Do not wait until June. Installation Report can be submitted following the Installation.
- 2. Auxiliary President and Treasurer must be bonded by <u>August 31, 2024</u>. The bond can be paid by the Treasurer through MALTA. If you wish to mail a check, the bond application is available on MALTA. If not paid by <u>August 31, 2024</u>, the Department MUST submit for suspension by that date to allow time to mentor and rejuvenate the Auxiliary. Sec 814-Trustee.

TIP: Do not wait until the last minute. Bond can be paid any time after July 1st.

- 3. District dues must be remitted to the District Treasurer by <u>September 30, 2024</u>, as per National Bylaws Section 506. Dues are based on the Auxiliary membership as of <u>June 30, 2024</u>, at the amount established by the District Standing Rules. Sec 506.
- 4. If the President, Treasurer or Secretary are an annual member, their annual dues must be paid no later than <u>December 31, 2024</u>. As per National if dues are not paid by the President, Treasurer or Secretary by <u>January 4, 2025</u>, the Department must submit an e-mail or letter on <u>January 5, 2025</u>, requesting the non-paid Officer be relieved of their position. FYI.....Any annual member who does not pay their dues by <u>December 31, 2024</u>, are no longer a member in good standing. Be sure to check those membership cards at your January meeting.
