

Clarify member at Large voting rights

WHEREAS: Section 110, second bullet, first sub bullet says that Any Member at Large May Not hold an office at the Auxiliary, County Council, District, Department or National Level.

WHEREAS: Section 110 Members at Large – Rights of;

States that Any Member at Large May not be a Delegate...therefore cannot vote

WHEREAS: Section 801 Eligibility states that:

Any member in good standing shall be eligible to any office in the Auxiliary, County Council, District, Department or the National Organization in which they are a member.

WHEREAS: Section 602 – Composition states

The Composition of a Department Convention shall consist of: The National President and Past National Presidents, elected National Officers and the National Council Member, who are members in good standing in an Auxiliary within the Department.

WHEREAS: Section 703 – Composition states:

The National Convention of the Auxiliary shall be composed of: The National President and Past National Presidents, and all other elective and appointive National Officers

- So long as they remain a member in good standing in **the** Auxiliary

WHEREAS: These above sections conflict one another.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That Section 801 first bullet be changed to say: Any member in good standing belonging to **an** Auxiliary shall be eligible to hold any office in the Auxiliary, County Council, District, Department, or the National Organization.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Section 703 also is changed to state belonging to **an** Auxiliary.




